Checklist for Obtaining a Drivers Permit

After completing 4 hours of class the students are eligible and should be prepared for the written permit test. They will receive the permit application form in class and can now go to the Secretary of State to take the written permit and eye vision test. You will need to bring the following information to the Secretary of State.

- Permit Application that you filled out in class and signed by parent.
- Cash or check for \$20 made out to the Secretary of State.
- Eyeglasses or contacts if you wear them (you will take an eye exam)
- Social Security Card
- Certified copy of your birth certificate or valid passport
- Something with your current address on it (bank statement, report card etc.)
- Something with your signature on it (Social security card, valid passport etc.)
- Be accompanied by parent or guardian

Once you have your permit, you must accumulate 50 driving hours with an adult 21 years of age or older who has a valid drivers license (always make sure you have the original copy of your permit with you). Once you have completed your class room and BTW hours, have turned 16 and have had your permit for at least 9 months you are eligible to take your divers license.
